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Dr. Hale was highly accessible. He held office hours twice per week.

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Office hours often began 5-10 minutes later than stated on the syllabus. There were often a long wait time as well (which is no fault of Prof. Hale) but since we started late I felt that I was waiting a long time.

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The instructor was always available for consultation and willing to answer questions.

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The worksheet assignments directly covered lecture material, with calculations similar to the ones modeled in class.

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I think the worksheets were very comprehensive and I appreciate that there were no midterms.

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The worksheets were actually fun -- I don't normally enjoy math, but this math was immediately and readily applicable to real-world events (or extremely plausible scenarios) and much easier to retain.

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## **Fairness and impartiality of grading.**

I had the same issue in the Presidency class on the assignment grades. The TAs always will do 14.5/15 but not explain what you did wrong or what to improve on so you continue making the same mistakes. This class was much better about it but still very frustrating.

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Grades were always fair

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Logical feedback is provided when points are deducted on an assignment, allowing for improvement on following assignments.

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## **Instructional value of examinations. (5) Excellent, (4) Very good, (3) Good, (2) Fair, (1) Poor**

In true democratic fashion, Dr. Hale took a class vote on whether there should be a midterm or not. The students voted overwhelmingly to not have a midterm (and increase the weight of the homework assignments).
